I swore this session I was never going to vote for another bill that had another commission appointed by the Governor in it because we have so many of those, but I will vote for the bill to come up today and I hope the rest of you will vote for it. I think at least the Legislature, as a whole, should look at it and not just one committee taking it out. I know it's a lot of money and maybe we will never figure out how to get that money, but it's a concept that we need to look at and we keep talking about we've got to do something about secondary and elementary education to make it work.
