CLERK: Senator Rasmussen voting aye, Senator Schellpeper voting aye.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 2 nays on adoption of the amendment, Madam President.

SENATOR WILL: I move the advancement of LB 354 to E & R for engrossing.
