PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 410 is advanced. LB 410A.

SENATOR RASMUSSEN: Yes.

PRESIDENT MOUL: We will have call in votes. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Labeledz voting yes, Senator Hall voting yes. Senator Coordsen voting yes. Senator Will voting yes.

SENATOR MOORE: Roll call vote.
