

are they closing them now? Don't these things exist? Don't rules and regulations exist? And the answer is, they do not exist. What does exist is a little pamphlet I have in my hand here, which I would be glad to show to any of you. It is called "Guidelines for Closure of Unpermitted Solid Waste Disposal Facilities and Open Dumps" which is put out by the Department of Environmental Control. However, those guidelines do not have the force and effect of law and are merely educational and suggestive, not directive. And Senator Morrissey is correct in that right now under the law, there are no rules and regulations that are enforceable. There are merely these guidelines, and I hope that helps clarify the situation for you. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Seeing no one else wishing to speak on this issue, does Senator Schmit have closing?

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: First of all, I guess I would ask the Clerk, is this AM0484?

CLERK: Well, it is AM0484 with the change on it, Senator.
