SENATOR WESELY: Sure. Madam President, members, I need to clarify. All we're doing here is changing a term as to how these individuals are described. The number of hours that they must go into training, and the scope of practice that they are able to apply are not changed in the least. The only term changed is from nursing assistant to being able to be identified as a qualified nursing assistant, because they've done the training and gotten...passed the test. So it is a very minor terminology change to try and recognize individuals who have achieved that level of training. With that, I'd move for advancement of the bill, unless there are questions.
