As long as we're going to be consistent and talk about safety, and talk about saving lives, let's go ahead and be consistent for all people and say, listen, if you've had two moving violations, might be parking ti...excuse me, it may be something that's relatively minor, but nonetheless if you have some of these things, if you have the points mentioned on pages 4 and 5, to warrant the test, that it apply to all people. I think Senator Beutler is on the right track, and I would hope the amendment would be agreed to.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Bernard-Stevens. Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: Madam President, members, we oftentimes like to personalize these bills. And I guess in my case I look at Senator Beutler's amendment and I think about the fact that if education really kept you from...made you drive better, it certainly didn't work for me. I took driver's ed when I was 15, and I've taken a defensive driving course three times, once cause my mother made me, once cause the state made me because I drove state cars, once cause the court made me because I got too many speeding tickets, and took it three times, took driver's ed. I'm 30 years old, I've owned 6 cars, and for the first time ever I traded one off this summer, first 5 I wrecked one way or the other, to tell you the truth. (Laughter.) And so I don't know if it actually will do what it intends to. For the reasons that personally Senator Beutler's amendment would have kept me in driver's ed class so much I probably never could have had time to run for this body. I'm going to have to oppose this amendment I guess.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Moore. Senator Kristensen.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Madam President, Senator Moore, we can only wish that LB 336 would have been in effect when you were a youngster. After riding home with you the other evening, I'm still not so sure that it isn't appropriate. I would hate to see you take it a fourth time and fail.
