I believe there were two other appointments that were not confirmed or reappointed or not at this point. Gerald comes to us from Richardson County. He has been self-employed as a farmer and has served on the Richardson County Commission, on a hospital board. And, with that, I recommend that Gerald Bucher be appointed to the Nebraska Retirement Systems Board and for the full approval of the Legislature.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Nelson. Are there any senators wishing to speak on this confirmation report? If not, we will proceed to vote. All those in favor of the confirmation report please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the approval of the confirmation report as offered by the Retirement Systems Committee.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Mr. Gerald Bucher is confirmed. We will now proceed with Item 6 on the agenda which is Final Reading. Would the senators all please return to their seats so that we can proceed with Final Reading. Thank you, senators. We will now proceed with Final Reading of LB 25.

CLERK: (Read LB 25 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 25 pass? All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 908 of the Legislative Journal.) 36 ayes, 0 nays, 13 excused and not voting, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 25 passes. Before we proceed with reading of the next bill, I would like to direct your attention to the south balcony where there are a 100 guests of the Legislature who will be having luncheon with the senators at noon.
