LB 233, 264, 311, 336

CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 911-12 of the Legislative Journal.) 41 ayes, 0 nays, 8 excused and not voting, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 233 passes. I would like to direct your attention again to the south balcony. Special guests today of Senator Schmit are 12 David City High School students and their teacher. Would you rise and be recognized. We will proceed with Final Reading on LB 264.

(LB 311. Title read. Standing Committee amendment AM0165, as found on page 556, considered. See page 913 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you for the indulgence, Madam President. Members of the body, the committee amendment would add in the definition section, on page 3 of the lines 9 through 14 in the bill, it would add the page...on page 3, line 11, we would strike the "or" and after "plans" we would add "or health and accident benefits", so that the amendment would read, "Fringe benefits shall include sick and vacation leave plans, disability income protection plans, retirement, pension, profit-sharing plans, or health and accident benefits and any other employment benefits". The committee felt that adding this into the legal definition of fringe benefits would enhance the clarity of this particular section. With that, I would move for the adoption of the committee amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Does any senator wish to speak on the committee amendments? Seeing none, do you have a closing? Closing is waived.
