delay the implementation of 234 for this very minor piece, the Department of Insurance agrees that it would be wise simply to excise this language from the bill, realizing that several other guarantees are there, and then we can proceed with 234 this year, and if we need to, draft special notice language next year on the question of the relationship between the creditor and the debtor with respect to a subsequent extension or purchase of insurance rights. And with that, I would move adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Landis. Seeing no one wishing to debate this amendment, do you have closing? Closing is waived. We will proceed to vote on adoption of the Landis amendment to LB 234. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.
