

to the counties where they originated from and where that potential voter would be eligible to vote and would need to have the registration form submitted to that election official. So those are the three changes made in the committee...excuse me, in the committee amendments to the bill. I would call them basically technical amendments or clean-up amendments to allow the bill to function in an orderly fashion. I would urge adoption.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Hall. Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: I'm not going to take much time, Madam President, but I do want to just go one step further with the explanation. This is a bill which I call my taxation with representation bill because it would provide every taxpayer in Nebraska with a registration card. The Revenue Committee likes it, I think, or the Revenue...the Department of Revenue, and they're very...they've been very accommodating and very willing to work. I don't think there would be very many registration cards that would actually go back to the Department of Revenue so that part of the amendment, I think, is a very small matter. These cards that are put out by Redfield have, on the front of them, it says election commissioner, county clerk and then it has blank county, blank Nebraska and zip code. So you just fill in the county that you live in and the town and the state and you mail them right off to your county clerk or election commissioner. So I can't see where the Revenue Department is really going to have to fool with too many of these, but if they do, the Secretary of State is willing to pass them on to the appropriate clerk or election commissioner. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Schimek. Seeing no one else wishing to debate this issue, do you have closing, Senator Hall? Closing is waived. We will proceed to vote on the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 85. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the adoption of the committee amendments?
