SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I want to thank Senator Labedz and Senator Crosby for their support for the legislation. I hope all of you heard our expression of cooperation in trying to deal with the fiscal impact of the bill. It is a very important piece of legislation and would be advantageous, I think, for the state to move forward in and I ask for your support in the advancement of the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Wesely. We will now proceed to vote on the advancement of LB 433. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the advancement of LB 433. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: I guess I'll have to ask for a call of the house, Mr. Speaker. Call ins.

SPEAKER BAACK: We have a request for a call of the house. All those in favor of the house going under call vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: The house is under call. All members please report to the Chamber, take your seats and record your presence, please. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The house is under call. Call in votes will be accepted.

CLERK: Senator Will voting yes. Senator Ashford voting yes. Senator Warner voting yes. Senator Beyer voting yes.

SPEAKER BAACK: Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 433.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 433 is advanced. The call is raised. We will now proceed to LB 433A.

CLERK: Mr. President, 433A is a bill introduced by Senator Wesely. (Read title.) Senator, I do have your amendment. Would you like to offer that now?
