Please welcome Dr. Tom Baer. We will proceed now with Item 5 on the agenda, legislative resolutions. LR 31.

CLERK: Madam President, LR 31, introduced by Senator Schrock and a number of the members, is found on page 835 of the Journal; asks the Legislature to declare the week of March 10 to 16 as Nebraska Good Seed Week.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Schrock.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Madam President, members of the body, it's my pleasure to introduce LR 31, Nebraska Good Seed Week. LR 31 has been introduced by members of the Agriculture Committee and myself in observance of Nebraska Good Seed Week. The official observance is March 10 through March 16 and is a significant time of year in decision making and planning for the spring seeding and when choices and variety, seed source and seed quality are being made. It is often a time when we see the reawakening of the wheat crop from winter dormancy. The scheduling of Good Seed Week is also symbolic as all across the nation people will celebrate agriculture during the week of March 17 to 23rd and State Ag Day, 1991 on March 20th. Therefore, Good Seed Week is held first because good agriculture begins with good seed. The resolution recognizes the cooperative and highly productive relationship of the Nebraska Crop Improvement Association, Nebraska Seed Trade Association, the Department of Agriculture and the Institute of Agriculture and Natural Resources. And if I'm correct, this is the 60th year of the Nebraska Crop Improvement Association. Please join me in voting to adopt LR 31. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Schrock. Does anyone else wish to speak on this motion? If not, we will proceed to vote on adoption of LR 31. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of LR 31.
