PRESIDENT MOUL: Would you repeat the bill number that we're putting back on again.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 766, and it will go right after LB 408.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Speaker Baack. We'll now proceed with LB 44.

CLERK: Madam President, LB 44 introduced by Senator Baack. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 10, referred to Transportation, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Speaker Baack.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Madam President and colleagues. This is a very simple bill. What the bill does is it says that if a student is going to attain the year, the age of 14 years before October 15, they would be allowed to take a driver's education course in the summertime. The reason that this bill came about was I had a constituent whose son would be able to get a school permit in the fall and be able to drive back and forth to school but he would not attain the age of 14 until after the date when the driver's education course could be taken in his local area. And they wanted him to take driver's education before he was on the road driving back and forth to school. So what we are doing here is we are saying now they can if they are going to be 14 years old by the 15th of October, they could take the driver's education course when they are only 13. What they had to do in this case was he could take the written part of the course in Kimball and then that he had to wait until he turned 14 and then he had to take the other course about 50 miles away, they had to drive back and forth every day so he could take the driving part of it about 50 miles away.
