LB 333, 335

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Morrissey. Does anyone wish to speak on this bill? Seeing none, do you have closing? Closing is waived. We will proceed to vote on the advancement of LB 333. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of 333.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 333 is advanced. LB 335.

CLERK: LB 335, Madam President, introduced by Senator Smith. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 16, referred to Transportation, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you, Madam President. Members of the body, LB 335 is a bill that was brought to me at the request of the Liquor Control Commission. The purpose of the bill is to expand the prohibition on the possession, the use and the manufacture of false driver's licenses or I.D. cards. There has been a real problem that has been expressed to us by the Liquor Commission. It seems to be going where young people are increasingly using fictitious identification for the purchase of alcohol and it's important enough that the Liquor Commission has decided to make it its top legislative priority for 1991. Basically, what it does is changes or increases the...it identifies those reasons why it would be illegal. Basically, the display or possession of any cancelled, revoked, suspended, fictitious or fraudulently altered operator's license or I.D. card issued by this state, the use of another person's operator's license of I.D. card, the fact that it's illegal for a person to permit another person to use their operator's license or state I.D. card whether issued by any state and finally for the manufacture of any fraudulent license or I.D. card whether in this or any other state. That's the entire contents of the bill and I'd ask your support. Thank you.
