

members and if it is the same as those over 50, about 12 percent have attended these seminars. So they figure that if they are held quite frequently, only about 50 percent of that or 6 percent of the employees then would attend the seminars. So, Senator Robinson, it's guessed that we're talking about 470 to 500 employees and I would doubt that they would have to hire that many more staff or anyone else because they are already doing it already, but that's about the figures that we maybe are talking about, 470 or 500 people. I don't know if Senator Robinson got that or not.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Nelson.

SENATOR NELSON: A year, Senator Pirsch. It's about 20, 25 at a session.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Nelson. Senator Robinson.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Madam President, members of the body, Senator Nelson, you said, did you get that? No, I was...Senator Bernard-Stevens was bending my ear about something so I didn't get that. So would you like to fill me on that? I still have a question for you.

SENATOR NELSON: One thing, Senator Robinson, I learned when I was here a few years ago, we can talk one of these bills to death, so I think we're down to two or three minutes and I certainly would not do that to Senator Haberman as fast as I can. There are approximately 10,900 employees that could be affected. Currently, about 12 percent take advantage of it, so we'll say if they do it every four years, only 6 percent will take advantage of it, so we're talking 470 to 500 employees. I would doubt that it would take that much additional staff to do it. They are there, the information is there and the material is there, but you know when someone gets paid to do something, they are going to do it a little bit more often than voluntary. Thank you.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Well, I want to tell you, the two or three minutes doesn't bother me. If we have to talk about it, we have to talk about it. I have a question. Does the teachers have this same thing? Do they have a...can they attend a seminar under 50?

SENATOR NELSON: No, they cannot. I would assume that the
