CLERK:      Senator Schellpeper voting yes.    Senator Byars voting yes.    Senator Elmer voting yes.

PRESIDENT MOUL:    Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK:    25 ayes, 8 nays on the advancement of 254A.

PRESIDENT MOUL:    LB 254A advances.    We will raise the call. Proceed to LB 689.

CLERK:    Madam President, 689 was a bill introduced by Senator Beutler.    (Read title.)    Introduced on January 23, referred to Education, advanced to General File.    I have no amendments to the bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL:    Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER:    Madam President, members of the Legislature, this was a bill brought to me by the attorney for the Lincoln school district and applies to Lincoln only and it was designed to correct a mistake in a change that was made a couple of years ago in the laws.    A couple of years ago the laws were amended so that Sections 79-439 through 79-444 would not apply to Class IV school district which is Lincoln.    However, Lincoln needs those sections and they should apply to Lincoln and so what this bill does is reapply 440 through 444 to Lincoln and then reestablishes 79-906 as the operative section for Lincoln instead of 79-439 with regard to matters relating to school board meetings and special meetings and that's all it does. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL:    Thank you, Senator Beutler.    Does anyone wish to speak on this bill?    Seeing none, we'll proceed to vote.    All those in favor of the advancement of LB 689 please vote aye, opposed nay.    Have you all voted?    Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK:    33 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of 689.

PRESIDENT MOUL:    LB 689 is advanced.    LB 534.

CLERK:    LB 534 was a bill introduced by Senators Withem and Baack.    (Read title.)    Introduced on January 22, referred to Government, advanced to General File.    I have no amendments to the bill.
