SENATOR HARTNETT: Yes, we're allowing them not to...up to the major, the big standard of \$40 to \$50 per square foot.

SENATOR PIRSCH: Right.

SENATOR HARTNETT: They allow them to repair the existing streets, you know, if the city decides that or if the neighborhood decides that.

SENATOR PIRSCH: Well, yeah. But this...and this would be in the manner of the sprinkling or armor coating district...

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yeah.

SENATOR PIRSCH: ...but then the last sentence, that's what I really, I guess, need assurance on. The assessable paving repair shall be only those made with asphaltic concrete. Now what's asphaltic concrete?

SENATOR HARTNETT: I think that's either the asphalt or reasphalt streets.

SENATOR PIRSCH: That's the thick...

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yeah.

PRESIDENT MOUL: One minute.

SENATOR PIRSCH: ...layer of asphalt.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yeah, yeah.

SENATOR PIRSCH: The paving repairs shall be only those made with asphaltic concrete in previously developed areas which were not constructed, which were not constructed to city permanently.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Right. I think our time is about up. We can advance...if you have some questions, we can maybe take them up on Select File.

SENATOR PIRSCH: Okay. But you can't tell me that now then?

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yeah.
