PRESIDENT MOUL: The confirmation report is adopted.

CLERK: Madam President, Business and Labor Committee would report on the appointment of Mr. Dan Dolan as Labor Commissioner.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Coordsen.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Madam President. Members of the body, Mr. Dan Dolan has been appointed by the Governor as Director of the Department of Labor. He appeared before the committee and answered all of our questions very satisfactorily. He indicated to us that he has a wide ranging experience, both on the labor and management side of the issues that will...that he will have oversight over as Director of the Department of Labor.
