of Labor has to do this. This is a deficit bill that will simply appropriate \$54,300 to the Department of Labor to do that activity. They have already begun to do it by transferring a Lincoln inspector down to Omaha and it is just asking a little much of them to absorb that for six months till the fiscal year starts. So the first would appropriate some money to have the state really start doing the elevator inspections down in Omaha. Secondly, giving some money to the athletic commissioner, this is probably the most...the biggest emergency of all, I guess, as far as the fact is that there is not enough money in this program to pay the commissioner and staff salary right now and, as a matter of fact, the athletic commissioner did not draw a salary last month because there was no money there. The reason there was no money there is that this agency's budget is predominantly cash funded and the reason there is no money there is Hulk Hogan is not coming to town as much as he used to. And the bulk of the money from this commission...from this agency comes from a percentage of gate receipts from athletic events, predominantly professional athletic events, since there is very little to no professional boxing, the bulk of that comes from pro wrestling matches. And it is our hope that the Hulkster and his friends will be coming to town more in the future so there will not be any need for General Funds but, in this case, to get this agency through the end of the year we are injecting \$7,000 in General Funds to pay the bills through the end of the fiscal year. Third portion is Section 8 of the bill, Department of Administrative Services. Basically what we have is in the on line data entry system. It is actually down in the northeast corner of the first floor. John Rochford, I think all of you know, had brief heart palpitations about a month ago and this system actually broke down and the state could not issue warrants. It's a 15-year-old system. We patched it together with Band-aids but we really need to go ahead and develop the new system and get it going. This, actually the cost of this would be \$53,000 to develop the hardware and software to develop this new system so we can...I think we just think it's too...it's asking a little much to expect that Band-aid approach to work through July 1, we need to get going and develop a new system. This would not be General Funds, it would be Cash Fund drawing on what is basically a dormant fund and this would draw it almost totally down, a bill we changed a couple years ago on social security Cash Fund...and I'm looking for the definition of that. If you need that, I will give that to you. Fourth is the Department of Personnel. It's a temporary employee. It's a Cash Funded authority for the Department of Personnel for the
