SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 410.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. The E & R amendments are adopted.

ASSISTANT CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: Just to remind the body, this particular piece of legislation, LB 410, a while back the body failed to advance the A bill, and so now it's Select File, and you...if you advance the bill from Select File, then we ought to go back and advance the A bill, or you ought not to advance it to Select File, which I will be voting no. So I would ask for a machine vote on LB 410.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: I wasn't here when the bill was brought up on General File. Senator Moore, it is possible to pass legislation without an A bill. It does set up a deputy council for child welfare. And we would like to have the A bill...we will have a shot at the A bill again, but the bill can stand on its own without an A bill. So I would encourage support for the advancement of the bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL: We have had a request for a machine vote. All those in favor of the motion to advance LB 410 please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the motion to advance LB 410? Have you all voted? Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, I guess I will ask for a call of the house, please, and call ins.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Motion has been made to place the house under call. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 22 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Madam President.
