It doesn't affect any of the brands that are on the front or the rear, but just on the ribs. Currently, it seems like there is some brands that are on the ribs that really affect the value of the hide, and the hide is getting to be a big portion of the value of any livestock. And so what this amendment does, it does not affect any brand that is currently there, or anyone that is going to renew it, or transfer that current brand. This amendment only affects any new brands.
