SENATOR MORRISSEY: Thank you. Senator Robinson has closed and asked for a call of the house. All in favor of the house going under call vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 21 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: The house is under call. Would all senators please return to their seats. All those out of the Chamber please return to the Chamber. The house is under call. Senator Robinson, check in, please. Senator Rogers, looking for Senator Rogers. Looking for Senator Schrock, Senator Wehrbein, Senator Wesely, the house is under call. Senator Cudaback, please check in. Senator Haberman, please check in. Looking for Senator Lamb, Senator Beyer, Senator Rogers. Still looking for Senator Beyer, Senator Rogers, the house is under call. Senator Robinson, we can't find Senator Rogers, Senator Beyer will be here directly. Would you like to proceed with the roll...did you ask for a roll call vote? A roll call vote, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read roll call vote. See pages 1046-47 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 13 ayes, 26 nays.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: The amendment fails. Mr. Clerk, back to the bill.

ASSISTANT CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 297 to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: You've heard the motion to move LB 297 to E & R for engrossment. A machine vote has been requested. The house is still under call. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.
