SENATOR MORRISSEY: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 382.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: You've heard the motion to advance 382 to E & R. All those in favor say aye. Opposed. It is advanced. Mr. Clerk, LB...oh, excuse me, the E & R amendments are advanced. Back to the bill, Mr. Clerk. Senator Haberman.
