

SENATOR LANDIS: It's not to take that power away, it is to lay out for all a method and a process by which that can be done with some accountability and some guidance from this Legislature as to how that kind of discretion should be exercised.

SENATOR WESELY: Okay, thank you, Senator Landis.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Wesely. Is there other discussion? Senator Landis, do you wish to close on your motion to return? Senator Landis, do you wish to close?

SENATOR LANDIS: (Response inaudible.)

SPEAKER BAACK: We will now proceed to vote on the motion to return LB 237 to Select File. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 237 is returned. We'll now proceed to the Landis amendment. Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: I move the adoption of the amendment to the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: Is there any discussion? Seeing none, we will proceed to vote on the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Landis's amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Landis's amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk? We need a motion to readvance the bill to Final. Senator Landis so moves. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is readvanced. Anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, sir, I do. Senator Lindsay, I understand, Senator, the amendments you had printed on page 1049, you want to withdraw that.

SENATOR LINDSAY: That's correct.
