LB 142A, 410A

SPEAKER BAACK: We have a request for a call of the house. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 10 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: The house is under call. The house is under call. All members please report to the Chamber and record your presence. The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel, please leave the floor. We are under call. And call in votes have been authorized. The house is under call. Please record your presence. Call in votes have been authorized. We are voting on the advancement of LB 142A. Senator Ashford, Senator Bernard-Stevens, Senator Beutler, Senator Haberman, Senator Kristensen, Senator Moore, Senator Morrissey.

CLERK: Senator Lamb voting yes.

SPEAKER BAACK: Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 7 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 142A advances. We'll now go to LB 410A. I'm going to leave the house under call for a few minutes so we can get this done.

CLERK: Mr. President, 410A was a bill introduced by Senator Wesely. (Read title.) I do have an amendment to the bill from Senator Wesely. (Wesely amendment appears on page 1133 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you. Mr. Speaker, members, this amendment would reduce the fiscal note by \$10,000, from 69,000 to 59,000 dollars. I'd ask for support of the amendment, then we can discuss the issue.

SPEAKER BAACK: Is there any discussion on the amendment by Senator Wesely? Seeing none, all those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment to the bill.
