SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. Speaker, I move the advancement of LB 724 to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER BAACK: We do have a request for a board vote. Is that correct, a board vote? Senator Smith, a board vote? We do have a request for a board vote. We will do that. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We're voting on the advancement of LB 724. Have you all voted? Senator Crosby.

SENATOR CROSBY: Request a call of the house and I'll take call in votes. Well, here's Senator Schmit, maybe I won't need one. Come on, Loran.
