

SENATOR WARNER: Motion to advance 232. Those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. Motion carried, the bill is advanced. LB 44, Senator...Mr. Clerk, are there amendments on the desk?

CLERK: Mr. President, there are. I have no E & R. Senator Baack would move to amend his bill, however. (Baack amendment appears on page 1079 of the Journal.)

SENATOR WARNER: Senator Baack.

SPEAKER BAACK: Yes, Mr. Chairman and colleagues, just a...this is a very brief amendment to LB 44. When the bill drafters were putting this together they found that one of the sections, in dealing with the section of statute that we're changing, was put into the middle of a section that deals with learners' permits. There is no reason that it should be in that section with the learner's permit. This simply takes the language and puts it into a new section of law, rather than including it in learners' permits, because it has nothing to do with learners' permits. Has to do with driver education. It just takes the language out of the learner permit section, puts it into Section 4 of the bill, creates a new section for the bill. If there's any questions, I'll be glad to answer them. That's all the amendment does. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR WARNER: Is there any discussion? Seeing none, those in favor of the Senator Baack amendment vote aye, opposed vote nay. Takes 25 votes. Would you please record your vote. Clerk, record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Baack's amendment.

SENATOR WARNER: Okay, motion carried, the amendment is adopted. Is there anything further on the desk?

CLERK: Nothing further, Mr. President.
