

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members of the body. Senator Abboud is right, LB 807 was in the Transportation Committee. It received a hearing there, and we did put that onto the floor of the Legislature. There were amendments, if you look in your bill book, to 807. Those amendments that would have been committee amendments that we would have required and wanted to make sure was on the bill, those have been included in Senator Abboud's amendment here to the bill. So, in terms of the way it came out of committee, the way that the committee heard the bill and received the information, that is still intact with Senator Abboud's amendment. And in terms of people, there was no one to testify against it. We would also agree, I think at least from my position, that this is a bill or an amendment that is in good shape, and I have no problems with it being attached to the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: Is there any further discussion? Senator Abboud, do you wish to close? He waives closing. We'll now proceed to vote on the amendment by Senator Abboud. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Abboud's amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: The Abboud amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill?

CLERK: Nothing further, Mr. President.
