SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Hartnett.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, after this bill advanced off General File, Senator Beutler raised a question about the payment schedule. And what it does, it simply clarifies that in...if the amount is less, total amount of assessment be paid in less than 10 years if, in each year the payment schedule...excluding interest, is \$500. So to clarify that, there is a payment schedule, and it can be less than 10 years, and that's really only the purpose of the amendment as brought by Senator Beutler. So there is a payment schedule. They don't have to pay it all at once. And so it's simply a clarifying amendment. So I...it was Senator Beutler's amendment brought to me, and so I agree with the amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Is there any discussion of the Hartnett amendment? Seeing none, Senator Hartnett, do you wish to close? He waives closing. We will proceed to vote on the Hartnett amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.
