

CLERK: Senator Horgan voting no.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Withem.

SENATOR WITHEM: Roll call vote.

SPEAKER BAACK: Roll call vote has been requested. We are still waiting for Senators...

SENATOR WITHEM: Reverse order, too, if possible.

SPEAKER BAACK: Roll call vote in reverse order. We are still waiting for Senator Bernard-Stevens and Senator Moore. All senators are now present. We have a request for a roll call vote in reverse order. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote commenced.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Reverse order.

CLERK: Reverse order, you're right. Excuse me, Senator. (Roll call vote taken. See page 1204 of the Legislative Journal.) 26 ayes, 14 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Schmit's amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Schmit's amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Wehrbein would move to amend. (The Wehrbein amendment appears on page 1205 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Raise the call. Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, Mr. President, and members, while you're here, I would like to have you consider...this is striking the second part of the Beutler amendment that we adopted to the committee amendments a few minutes ago. It's the second half having to do with the section on page 2, and that's where we got into the increase in the fees, 5 percent on January 1st, '94, and on each January 1st thereafter, and 10 percent on January, 1998, and thereafter. This first section I do not touch or the first part of that amendment. We have discussed this, it seems to me that there was quite a bit of opposition to this on the floor.
