SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 133 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 1242-43 of the Legislative Journal.) 41 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 6 excused and not voting, Mr. President.
