PRESIDENT MOUL:    Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL:    Madam President, I move the advancement of LB 334 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT MOUL:    You've heard the motion to advance LB 334. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. LB 334 is advanced. LB 284.

CLERK:    LB 284, Senator, I do have E & R amendments pending.

PRESIDENT MOUL:    Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL:    Madam President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 284.

PRESIDENT MOUL:    You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK:    I have nothing further on this bill, Senator.

PRESIDENT MOUL:    Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL:    Madam President, I move the advancement of LB 284 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT MOUL:    You've heard the motion to advance LB 284. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. LB 284 is advanced. LB 303.

CLERK:    Senator, no E & R. I do have an amendment. Senator Warner would move to amend the bill by adding the emergency clause.

PRESIDENT MOUL:    Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER:    Madam President, members of the Legislature, this bill dealt with setting appraisal fees, you may recall from General File. It's noncontroversial, but it could be helpful if it took effect sooner than 90 days after the session adjourns. It could save some costs and for that reason I'd move to adopt the emergency clause.

PRESIDENT MOUL:    Thank you, Senator Warner. Is there anyone who
