E clause is important because we are expanding the rights of those people who make these appeals and this could be helpful to somebody before this bill would take effect otherwise. I ask the body to adopt the amendment and to advance the bill on to Final Reading. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Robak. Is there anyone who wishes to debate this amendment? Seeing none, we will vote on the motion to amend LB 561 with the E clause. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Robak's amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Senator, I have nothing further on the bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I move the advancement of LB 561 to E & R for engrossment.

CLERK: LB 700, I have no amendments to the bill, Senator.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I move the advancement of LB 700 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You've heard the motion to advance LB 700. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. LB 700 is advanced. LB 166.

CLERK: LB 166, Senator, does have E & R pending.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 166.
