PRESIDENT MOUL: Does anyone else wish to speak on the committee amendments? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Kristensen?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Yes, Madam President, and members, just real quickly to remind you what the committee amendments are. This is for a tolerance for any farm trucks with not more than two axles within 70 miles of the farm. It would permit a 5 percent in excess of what the maximum amount allowed by law or 5 percent overweight tolerance. This is only for grains or other seasonally harvest products to go from the field to the farm storage, to the market or to a stockpile within the field. With that, I would move the amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. We will now vote on the motion to adopt the committee amendments to LB 170. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The committee amendments are adopted. Senator Coordsen, would you like to open on the bill itself?

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Madam President. I would move LB 170, as amendment...as amended.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Mr. Clerk, you have a motion on the desk.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Warner would move to indefinitely postpone the bill. Senator Coordsen would have the option to lay the bill over if he were so inclined, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Coordsen.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Let's take it up.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Warner.
