

have come up with a couple other good ideas. Senator Schimek has a couple amendments to offer as well. We're going to offer those separate rather than try to go back, incorporate them and reprint them all into the one body, so those are also amendments that I think we can be very supportive of and will make this, this whole process work better for us. So with that, that is the large amendment and will certainly be available for questions and I'll turn my light on to respond to other comments as we go.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Conway. I'll now recognize the senators in the following order, oh, we do have amendments on the desk. Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Madam President, the first amendment I have to AM0868 is an amendment from Senator Conway and that is to attach the emergency clause.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Conway.

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Madam President. As I mentioned as I was talking about the large amendment itself, what I am asking now to do is to attach the E clause. I think it's imperative that in order for this commission to work in the way that we have it designed, that they come back to this body in early of next year with any statutory changes that are necessary to implement for the next election cycle, and so the sooner that we can have these people on board and create this commission, the better off and the more time they are going to have to work through those issues. So I believe it's imperative enough, like I say, it's my priority bill that I have chosen in order to make this as a vehicle to do it and would like to see the E clause attached so that the Governor can start making these appointments, formulating this commission so they have plenty of time to bring back their ideas to this body for statutory changes next year to be in the proper election cycle, so I request that you support me in behalf of attaching the E clause.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Conway. I'll now recognize senators wishing to speak to the amendment to the amendment which is the E clause. The following senators have their lights on. Senator Withem, do you wish to speak to this?
