

CLERK: Senator Chambers would move to amend, Madam President. (Chambers amendment appears on page 1332 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam Chair and members of the Legislature, this is an amendment which may seem to be nit picking, but if you turn to page 6 in lines 14 and 15, with reference to the types of opinion that can be issued by the commissioner you see the term "verbal." All I want to do is strike "verbal" in both instance and insert the word "oral" as opposed to written because it says further on that a written opinion can then be offered to coincide with as written now, verbal opinion. Verbal can refer to written or unwritten so it's not that significant an amendment, may not be important, but I would like to have oral inserted so that it is clear we mean a spoken as opposed to written opinion and then later on a written opinion can be written to coincide with it. So I am asking that you adopt this amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Is there anyone wishing to speak on the Chambers amendment? Seeing none, do you have closing? Closing is waived. We'll vote on the Chambers amendment to the Conway amendment. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.
