SENATOR CONWAY: Mr. Speaker, I would like to request a call of the house and call in votes, please.

SPEAKER BAACK: We have a request for a call of the house. All those in favor of the house going under call vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: The house is under call. All members please report to the Chamber and record your presence. The house is under call. Call in votes have been authorized.

CLERK: Senator Lynch voting yes.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Bernard-Stevens, would you check in. Senator Beutler, would you check in, please. Looking for Senators Moore and Lindsay. Call in votes have been authorized. We are voting on the advancement of LB 579.

CLERK: Senator Bernard-Stevens voting yes. Senator Landis and Senator Lindsay voting yes. Senator Byars voting yes.

SPEAKER BAACK: Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the advancement of 579.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 579 advances. The call is raised. We will now proceed to LB 748, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, 748 was considered yesterday. At that time, the committee amendments were adopted. There was an amendment to the bill by Senator Elmer that was adopted. Senator Morrissey offered a motion to indefinitely postpone the bill. Senator Johnson chose to lay the bill over. The motion to indefinitely postpone is now pending.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Morrissey, on the motion to indefinitely postpone.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: Thank you, Mr. President and members. I retain my argument from yesterday that this bill is not needed
