PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Johnson. I will now recognize Senator Morrissey, followed by Senator Elmer. Senator Morrissey.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: Thank you, Madam President and members. Folks, it is really tough when you are arguing against no argument. It really gets tough, and that is the way it has gone for three years, and I am not going to say much more about that, but when the arguments all take place in the lobby and they can't even bring them to the floor and use them, it is hard to refute them. Senator Johnson's amendment is better than it was written. Now the last two lines, Senator Johnson, if you would answer a question, please. Again, I will state, it is not needed, but line 8 and 9, or 7, 8, 9, it says, if all of the other requirements necessary for approval of the license to receive radioactive waste have been met. Is the license, is that a separate section of the license for siting, or does one license cover siting, design, and the ability to receive radioactive waste?

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Senator, my understanding, I asked my legal counsel to draft this up, would be as it says, only if all of the other requirements, so I am assuming that takes into account all three of those areas that you covered.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: How about if we just said if all the requirements necessary for approval of a license, and just make it pretty clear that all the requirements, not to receive waste, but also for building, for construction, for siting design, everything? If we just say certain real estate legally described as follows, only if all of the requirements necessary for approval of a license have been met.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Senator, I will not give you a specific answer because right now I need to look at that, but I will answer your question at the appropriate time.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: Okay, and that is my problem, this issue, folks, if you put a comma in the wrong place, or a period in the wrong place, you can get into big trouble. I discovered that over three years, and we have to go through these documents very carefully to understand what we are doing. And I don't understand for sure if this is saying the whole licensing
