

of dirt, and we will own that property, and that is the way it reads, but we will own that property and that is a piece of that property, and we will own that facility. And through what the NRC has told me, just because that is buried on that property, it is naturally the State of Nebraska's property, and we don't have guaranteed liability with these other states locked up. We pass this and they balk on that, they have no reason to, no reason to do it. They get to license that then, and we don't have shared states' liability, they can build it anyway, and they will build it anyway. And that is just fine with a lot of you, and it really makes me just a little mad that you can be comfortable with a situation like that. And I have never stood on this floor and say I am here to block this facility. I have never said that to anyone here or any of my constituents. I have gone out of my way to say, if it is done correctly, I can't say it should be stopped. But get out the rules and regs, and get out the low-level act and read that just once, just once.

PRESIDENT MOUL: One minute.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: And you realize if you pass this bill that these states can come in and have their way with us, and you said that is fine. And they no longer have any need to pass LB 837, which is a bill we are asking them to put in writing what they promised us all along. Simple, simple as that, and that is it. Thanks.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Morrissey. Mr. Clerk, do you have a priority motion on the desk?

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Dierks would move to bracket LB 748 until January 15, 1992.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Dierks.

SENATOR DIERKS: Madam President and members of the body, this bracket motion will not be withdrawn. I have got it up there for a definite purpose and I intend to see that we vote on the issue. There is no hurry for this legislation. What this legislation says it can be taken care of very well after January 15, next year.
