

obligation under the law. If there is any time remaining, Mr. Speaker, I would give it to Senator Elmer for closing.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Elmer, you have about one minute.

SENATOR ELMER: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Senator Johnson summed it up very well. There is very little...one other point I would make. Senator Morrissey has said these other states are going to come up here, throw us out, put that site on the Boyd County land. If the license is denied, the state's not going to own the land and they're certainly not going to come back and reapply for another license in the State of Nebraska on a site where the license has failed. That's a moot point. I would ask for the advancement of 748.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Elmer. You have now heard the closing on the advancement of LB 748. We will now proceed to vote on the advancement. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We're voting on the advancement of LB 748. Have you all voted? Senator Johnson.
