SENATOR WITHEM: Senator...and I've turned my light on, because we may want to continue this dialogue. So, if I use too much of your time, you can use some of mine here. Senator Crosby was another individual appointed to this. We, I believe, just confirmed her a week ago. There are other bills pending that Mr. Herman has editorialized on that he doesn't think we should have legislative members serving on those. And as we create new commissions, we can make that legislative determination. I think that was the issue that was raised earlier.

SENATOR WESELY: Is this particular commission ongoing, or is there a sunset provision for it?

SENATOR WITHEM: Oh, I think it's a...I think it sunsets...commission shall terminate and be dissolved effective June 30, 1992.

SENATOR WESELY: Okay, all right. What page is the Attorney General Opinion on?

SENATOR WITHEM: I have a copy of it in my hand, I don't know what page it is on. I'm referring from a...it's a March 7th opinion, so it would be somewhere in that area.

SENATOR WESELY: Okay, I'm going to rise in support of this confirmation of David Bernard-Stevens, having had the discussion I just did with Senator Withem. I think legitimately we need to be cognizant of the potential problem of...

SENATOR WESELY: ...raised by the Attorney General Opinion. But I think Senator Withem is right, there's a bill that's been passed that needs to be fully implemented. And pending further review of the opinion and of the issue, I think we ought to go ahead and proceed.
