PRESIDENT MOUL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 253 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 1357 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 43 ayes, 0 nays, 3 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 253 passes with the emergency clause. I'd like to direct your attention again to the south balcony. Senator Lowell Johnson has the following guests in the Legislature today. They are 65 fourth graders from Linden Elementary School in Fremont, Nebraska, with their teachers. Would you please all rise and be recognized by the Legislature. Welcome. While the Legislature is in session and capable of conducting business, I propose to sign and do sign the following legislative bills: LB 356, LB 356A, LB 324, LB 325, LB 340, LB 363, LB 363A, LB 382, LB 498, and LB 253. Mr. Clerk, do you have items for the record?

CLERK: I do, Madam President. Your Committee on Nebraska Retirement Systems, whose Chair is Senator Nelson, reports LB 549 to General File with amendments attached, signed by Senator Nelson. Enrollment and Review reports LB 166, LB 199, LB 284, LB 303, LB 334, LB 343, LB 454, LB 561, and LB 700 as correctly engrossed, signed by Senator Will. Enrollment and Review also reports LB 409, LB 409A to Select File with E & R amendments attached. That's all that I have, Madam President. (See pages 1358-63 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: We will proceed with General File. LB 181.

CLERK: Madam President, 181 was introduced by Senators Chizek, Kristensen, Lindsay, Will, Rasmussen, Horgan, Abboud, Lynch and Ashford. (Read title.) The bill was considered yesterday. I have no amendments pending at this time, Madam President.
