LB 254, 355, 470, 582, 586, 671, 732, 773

SENATOR HARTNETT: This is my priority bill and we spent a long time on it and we're kind of back to where we were when we started at noon. But I think that's fine so I would simply ask my priority bill to be advanced. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Hartnett. Is there anyone else who wishes to speak on this bill? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Hall? Closing is waived. Proceed to vote on advancement of LB 773. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the advancement of LB 773? Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the motion to advance LB 773.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 773 is advanced. Mr. Clerk, do you have items for the record?

CLERK: Madam President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 582 and LB 586 correctly engrossed. (See pages 1371-72 of the Legislative Journal.) Amendments to be printed. Senator Landis to LB 470; Senator Haberman to LB 732; and Senator Robinson to LB 254. (See pages 1372-77 of the Legislative Journal.)

And, Madam President, Senator Landis would move to place LB 671 on General File, pursuant to Rule 3, Section 19(b). That will be laid over.

That's all that I have.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We will proceed again with General File, LB 355.

CLERK: Madam President, LB 355 was a bill originally introduced by Senators Ashford, Will, Crosby, Beutler, Chambers, Wesely, Rasmussen, Schimek, Hall and Landis. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 16, referred to the Judiciary Committee. The bill was advanced to General File.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Ashford, would you please open.
