SENATOR HEFNER: ...you to vote against this amendment. I have a kill motion that will come up right after this amendment. I urge you to vote against this amendment and then vote for the kill motion.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Hefner. Senator Ashford.

SENATOR ASHFORD: Thank you, Madam President. I just would ask Senator Hefner a couple of questions so that I understand what his position really is, if I could. Senator Hefner, I'm not confused by what you said. I...you are against gun control and you certainly said it with great clarity and, by the way, I respect your opinion, but what I don't understand is what your rationale was for signing onto LB 801. Could you explain that to me?

SENATOR HEFNER: Yes, Senator Ashford, I can. I signed onto 801 because I felt that this would be better than LB 355.

SENATOR ASHFORD: Can you tell me what the fiscal note is on LB 801?

SENATOR HEFNER: Yes.

SENATOR ASHFORD: Can you...

SENATOR HEFNER: Very, very great. Very great.

SENATOR ASHFORD: It's about \$180,000 in state funds.

SENATOR HEFNER: And this is why I have offered a kill motion on 355.
