SENATOR COORDSEN: Certainly would have. This is, as I said, not an all inclusive list. Anything that is permissible under the current language under interlocal agreements, which would include the additions that you would seek to make with this amendment would be permissible under 731 agreements.

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Senator Coordsen.

SENATOR COORDSEN: I might...may I continue just...

SENATOR CONWAY: Sure.

SENATOR COORDSEN: ...a second on your time. It was brought to my attention that it is not, however, the intent of the bill that this be used for the condemnation or the purchase of natural gas pipeline systems equipment or things of that nature, but rather those that are permissible under the currently existing language of the interlocal agreement. Certainly would include community buildings, libraries, anything that would fit under the current language.

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Again, my concern was because we had such an extensive list that it not be interpreted to really mean that this would be the all inclusive list and that I have some areas in my district where they are seriously talking about the cooperative efforts potentially of getting into the construction or the physical involvement relative to libraries and senior citizen centers and these kinds of things between counties and cities and the like. And so I wanted to make sure that your intent was not to exclude, but had those been thought of, they would have been included in the list as well. And so, with that as part of the record, I am totally comfortable to withdraw my amendment and allow 731 to be read as originally printed.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Conway. Would the senators all return to their seats so that we can proceed with Final Reading. Thank you, senators. We will proceed with reading LB 731E.
