

here and buy our carpet because you get outside the city sales tax. I think it's, in this case, although you could make the argument, and I think that's the argument in opposition to this, that things ought to be done uniformly. And we clearly do everything uniformly here. I see no problem with the issue of the tax situs on flowers. Now we have had this bill in front of the committee, I know, for at least the three years that I've sat on the committee, and I think that it does one thing, it makes it very easy for the collection of tax, it guarantees the collection of tax, and it leaves little ambiguity for the individuals who collect the sales tax for us, that being the florist. I would urge you to override the veto. If memory serves me, there was no opposition to this proposal when it was before the body.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Hall. I'll now recognize senators in the following order--Senator Schimek, Senator Crosby, Senator Pirsch, and Senator Warner. Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Madam President, members of the body, I just have a question. And I don't know, maybe Senator Johnson could answer this for me. It just occurred to me, where it didn't occur earlier when we were debating the bill. Senator Johnson, does this bill have any impact on interstate sales? For instance, if a florist delivers flowers over to Council Bluffs from Omaha, does this, does this impact that at all? Does it change the way...or does it change the amount of taxes collected?

SENATOR L. JOHNSON: It should not, in my opinion it would not change.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Right now, right now the way it is?

SENATOR L. JOHNSON: I can't tell you what the actions are of Omaha florists delivering into Council Bluffs would be, whether they collect the tax...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Currently, though, the way the law reads they would collect the tax at Council Bluffs. No, they couldn't do that.

SENATOR L. JOHNSON: We have here in front of us a draft at least, or Department of Revenue item on that, do I collect sales tax on orders I fill and deliver outside of Nebraska? The
