

answer is, no.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Okay, thank you. I just...I was just curious. It just occurred to me. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Schimek. Senator Crosby.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Madam President and members. I rise to support the override. And I would like to point out one thing, the bill says deliver live plants or floral arrangements. The word arrangements would include balloons that are part of that floral arrangement. So I don't think that you have any...I don't think there would be any problem as to merchandise and so on, like a little bird, or whatever, is placed into the arrangement. And I'm just pleased that Senator Lynch brought the override to us this morning, because there again so many of the florists are what we consider small businesses. And I think we should try to help them run their business in a timely manner. And again I'd point out, as Senator Hall did and Senator Lynch, it's not a matter of not collecting a tax, it's simply where it is collected. So I do support the override. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Crosby. Senator Pirsch.

SENATOR PIRSCH: Thank you, Madam President. Members of the Legislature, this is not an isolated incident just on florists. If you had a lumberyard in Irvington, Senator Hall, if you had a lumberyard in Irvington, who delivered lumber to your house, you would pay tax on the delivery as well as the lumber. However, if you hire Joe Blow to go pick up the lumber, you would not pay a tax on that service, to pick up your lumber. I think this whole issue needs some looking into. And I'm going to support the override just to kind of force some issues of looking at these delivery kind of things, which to me are tax on services, not tax on the product. And supposedly we do not have tax on service in Nebraska. And I think we should force this issue, and I'm going to support the override.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Pirsch. Senator Warner, followed by Senators Will and Abboud. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I voted for this bill, I voted it out of committee, and it sounded very logical, still does sound very logical, except when I read
