Law enforcement agencies, contrary to what Senator Hefner said yesterday, are not held liable under this act, are not held liable under this act. Senator Hefner had not read the amendment. Section 4. Any person whose certificate is denied or revoked may repeal...appeal within 10 days to the county court. A \$10 filing fee is required and the court shall issue its decision within 30 days. Section 5. The annual certificate shall contain the name, social security, address, birth date and the effective date of the certificate. The certificate, colleagues, authorizes the holder to acquire any number of handguns statewide during the period of time that the certificate is valid. Every time you purchase a handgun, you don't have to have a check like you do on 801. So this, again, accomplishes what everybody says they're trying to accomplish in the least offensive manner. Section 6. Any person providing false information on an application form or willfully violating this law would be guilty of a Class IV felony. Any city...Section 7. Any city or village ordinance existing on the effective date of this act shall not be preempted. Section 8 defines a handgun or any firearm with a barrel...

SPEAKER BAACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHIZEK: ...of less than 16 inches in length or any firearm to be designed to be fired by the use of a single hand. This, colleagues, is the federal definition. This also defines antique guns. Willful...and I will go back to Senator Schellpeper's letter, willful means not accidental, that it...I mean, if it is an accident, if it's a mistake, excuse me, colleagues, then it can't be willful. So it's very clear. And if those are the only problems we have and if we are going to deal with something in 1991,...

SPEAKER BAACK: Time.

SENATOR CHIZEK: ...this, again, is the least offensive. Again, I would ask your support for the amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Chizek. We will go to Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I rise to oppose the Chizek amendment on this gun control bill.
