Senator Lynch is now here. We will proceed to vote. We're voting on the motion to indefinitely postpone.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 1396-97 of the Legislative Journal.) 16 ayes, 22 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: The motion fails. Anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk? The call is raised. Have items for the record first.
