

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Ashford would move to amend. Senator, I have AM0847 in front of me.

SENATOR ASHFORD: Mr. Speaker and members, this is the Schellpeper amendment which I have just signed onto. And as the body knows, I do not support the Schellpeper amendment but I think it's appropriate that we take it up right now. I'm not sure what Senator Schellpeper was getting at by withdrawing the amendment, and he can explain that to us and why he has decided to move it over to Select File, but I think let's take up the Schellpeper amendment, let's find out whether this body wants an instant check in LB 801, Senator Schellpeper. So I would go...let's go ahead and take up LB 801.

SPEAKER BAACK: I'm going to go through my list of speakers, and if you wish to speak on this amendment, just signify. Senator Robak. No. Senator Schellpeper, did you wish to speak to this amendment?

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Mr. Chairman, yeah, I will take it up, I have no problem with that. I just...but I'm going to refile it again on Select because I think that we can work out some things on the bill. We're going to get some more information. But I think the bill, as I presented it, 801, in the hearing, is a much better way to go. The amendment or the bill that we have right now before us, in the amended form, it does affect gun shows. Yeah, Senator Ashford said that it does not. It does affect gun shows. You have to have a permit before you go to that gun show. So I think everyone knows what LB 801 is. I just hope that you will support LB 801. Thank you.

SENATOR BAACK: Senator Ashford, your light is on. Did you wish to discuss this amendment?

SENATOR ASHFORD: Yes, thank you, Mr. Speaker and members. I have handed out a couple of handouts that I would appreciate it if you would look at. I think they were the last two handouts that we have in front of you. One is a letter from Ron Tussing, Colonel of the or Superintendent of the Nebraska State Patrol. And in his letter of March 12, he wrote pretty much what he had said in the hearing or what was said in the hearing by the State Patrol, by a representative of the State Patrol, and let me just read to you what he says, partially. "The requirement of a response during the licensee's telephone call or by return call is dependent upon a fully computerized system. Our records are
